

Health and Safety Measures for Cultural Events at the Deutsch-Amerikanisches Institut (DAI)

In order to avoid Covid-19 infections, the following hygiene requirements and rules must be followed at cultural events at the German-American Institute Nürnberg:

- Stay home if you feel sick or have had contact with a person in the past 14 days who got tested positive on Covid-19.
- Tickets or registration for events are necessary.
- We may reschedule or cancel events due to certain circumstances.
- Wear a medical face mask. You can take off the mask when you sit down as long as you put at least 1,50 m of distance between yourself and other people.
- At an incidence rate of over 35 in the City of Nuremberg the 3G rules apply. Only people who are fully vaccinated, recovered from or tested negative on Covid-19 are allowed entrance.
- Avoid crowds.
- No group works.
- Tables, doorknobs etc. will be disinfected after each event.
- Regular ventilation every 45 minutes and after each event.
- To identify contact persons in case of a later identified infection with Covid-19, we will transfer contact of visitors' details (name, address, contact details, time of visit) to the public health department.

Generally mind:

- Frequently wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Practice good respiratory etiquette, including covering coughs and sneezes or coughing/sneezing into your elbow/upper sleeve or into a tissue that is thrown away after.
- Stay at least 1,50 m away from others.
- Wear a medical face mask.
- Avoid physical contact with other people, such as touching or shaking hands.
- Avoid touching the same objects as other people.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Door handles, tables etc are to be disinfected after each event.
- Regular ventilation every 45 minutes and after each event.
- To identify contact persons in case of a later identified infection with Covid-19, we will transfer contact of visitors' details (name, address, contact details, time of visit) to the public health department.
