

Hygiene Protection Concept and Framework Conditions for Cultural Events at the German-American Institute

In order to avoid Covid-19 infections the following hygiene requirements and rules must be followed for cultural events at the German-American Insitutit Nürnberg e.V.:

- Individuals with cold symptoms (even with mild symptoms) are not allowed to attend the event
- Prior registration for events or purchase of tickets is necessary
- We reserve the right to change or move the program under certain circumstances
- It is compulsory to wear a mouth-nose protection when entering the house/venue. The mask may only be taken off at assigned seat.
- A minimum distance of at least 1.50 m between the visitors before, during and after the event must be observed. This can lead to a smaller than usual number of visitors at some events.
- No group formation (before, during or after the event)
- Avoid touching the same objects if possible
- Door handles/tables/etc. will be disinfected after the event
- Regular airing of the event room after 45 minutes and after each event is required
- In order to enable a contact person to be identified in the event of a subsequently identified COVID-19 case among the visitors or the participants, the contact details of the participants or visitors (surname, first name, place of residence, telephone number or e-mail address, period of stay/duration) will be sent to the competent health authorities on request

Basic Rules

- In case of (corona-specific) signs of illness (e.g. fever, dry cough, breathing problems, loss of the sense of taste/odor, sore throat, aching limbs, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea), visitors or participants need to stay at home
- Assure a good hand hygiene (regular hand washing with soap for 20 - 30 seconds)
- Adhere to coughing and sneezing etiquette (cough or sneeze into the crook of your arm or into a handkerchief)
- Keep a distance (at least 1.5 m) from other persons at all times, also when entering and leaving the building
- Wear a mouth-nose protection when entering and leaving the building
- No body contact (avoid handshakes and hugs)
- Keep hands away from your face (avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth)
