Habitat Games: Understand the Environment and then Act

Ecology, climate crisis, degradation, global warming, habitat, natural rejuvenation - all of which are fairly new terms - have become part of our everyday vocabulary. Although huge amounts of information are available, our everyday activities still continue to impact life on our planet. For years we have overlooked the interconnectedness of ecosystems and habitats. Now our own lives and the lives of our children are at risk.

A Habitat Game is a 90-minute, indoor, interactive, hands-on approach to understanding the complexity of our environment. Since we all share responsibility for the health of our planet, the game is student-centered. Each game begins with ‚water‘ in the form of an ocean. We introduce native plant and animal communities. We see what happens when we alter the landscape for city planning, farming and green houses. Materials are provided.
