Human Rights Workshop with Corinne Venema-Tucker



2018 marks the 70th anniversary of the signing of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, a document that lays out the principles upon which Human Rights Laws have been built and around which constitutions have been written.

In this workshop, your students will have the opportunity to research and explore this document and its articles to fully understand their own rights and the rights set out for all citizens of our global environment. They will also be able to explore the steps they, themselves can undertake when these rights are violated.

As the cities of Nuremberg and Atlanta are twinned, the students will also be able to explore and compare their own municipal's history to that of another, one drenched in its own political and civil rights' history.

This workshop is offered with a duration of either 2 UE, or, including a discussion and tour of the Way of Human Rights, 4 UE.
