## How Sustainable is the USA?

To most Europeans, the U.S. is better known as a country that has little to offer in the way of environmental protection. Gas-guzzling road cruisers and SUVs, seas of lights at all times of the day and night, packaging mania and the rejection of the Kyoto Protocol are images we associate with the country on the other side of the Atlantic. Nevertheless, the U.S. is now the world's largest market for organic products, nowhere else are more electric cars sold, and in politics, too, voices are increasingly being raised in favor of a more sustainable approach to the environment. The topic has gained in importance, not least due to Barack Obama. The aim of this workshop is to resolve the apparent and actual contradictions and to get to the bottom of them analytically. To this end, after an introductory lecture, the students will be divided into working groups to work together on different issues-oriented problems and then present their core results to the entire group.
