

## Hygiene Protection Concept and Framework Conditions for Language Courses at the German-American Institute

In order to avoid Covid-19 infections the following hygiene requirements and rules must be followed for language courses at the German-American Insititut Nürnberg e.V.:

- Individuals (even with mild symptoms) are not allowed to participate in language courses
- It is compulsory to wear a mouth-nose protection when entering the house. The mask may only be taken off at the place in the course room.
- A minimum distance of at least 1.50 m between the participants before, during and after the event must be observed
- No group formation (before, during or after the event)
- No exchange of working materials avoid touching the same objects if possible
- Group work is not permitted
- Door handles/work tables/reusable work materials will be disinfected after the course
- Regular airing of the seminar room after 45 minutes and after each course hour is required
- In order to enable a contact person to be identified in the event of a subsequently identified COVID-19 case among the participants or the course instructors, the contact details of the participants or the course instructors (surname, first name, place of residence, telephone number or e-mail address, period of stay/course duration) will be sent to the competent health authorities on request



## **Basic Rules**

- In case of (corona-specific) signs of illness (e.g. fever, dry cough, breathing problems, loss of the sense of taste/odour, sore throat, aching limbs, nausea/vomiting, diarrhoea), participants need to stay at home
- Assure a good hand hygiene (regular hand washing with soap for 20 30 seconds)
- Adhere to coughing and sneezing etiquette (cough or sneeze into the crook of your arm or into a handkerchief)
- Keep a distance (at least 1.5 m) from other persons at all times
- Wear a mouth-nose protection when entering and leaving the building
- No body contact (avoid handshakes and hugs)
- Keep hands away from your face (avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth)
